

## Flu vaccines

The arrival of our flu vaccine was delayed this year due to a manufacturing problem. Many patients have asked why we did not have the vaccine when other local practices had received their deliveries. The reason for this is that influenza vaccine is produced by several suppliers and is ordered by surgeries in February or March each year. The strain of influenza changes each year so the vaccine has to be grown from scratch. Unfortunately the supplier we ordered from experienced a growth failure and had to start again which put back our deliveries by approximately one month. At the time of writing we have just begun to receive our deliveries and have Clinics fully booked at 1 minute intervals for 3 Saturdays in November.

It helps the throughput of patients tremendously if all outer garments are removed and sleeves are rolled up before going in to the nurse for your injection. Please leave the room immediately after your jab and replace outer garments in the waiting room.

## A message from our Patient Participation Group

The Patient Participation Group (PPG) was formed in 2002 to provide facilities at the surgery for patients' use and since its inception has purchased a defibrillator, automatic doors, high chairs for the waiting room and many smaller items. At present funds are being raised for an automatic weighing machine for patients' own use. The group also delivers prescriptions to the local villages of Thurlby, Langtoft and Baston.

Keep it or cancel it!!!!

Did you know that we have a unique number you can use if you wish to cancel your surgery appointment?

The Surgery cancellation line is 01778 562202.

You can also use of web site to cancel your appointment provided you have registered you details with the Surgery. Please ask at reception if you would like further details on our web site.

During September 2006 there were 138 Patients who did not attend a pre booked appointment. This equates to 14 hours of General Practice time and 9 hours of Nurse Time (phlebotomy, treatment room, midwife etc)  
Please think of others, if you no longer need your appointment please ensure you cancel it as soon as possible so another patient can use the slot.

### Order your prescription early for Christmas

Our dispensary is always very busy in the weeks leading up to Christmas. It would be very helpful if patients could order their prescriptions at least one week early during December and give us 3 working days to dispense rather than the usual 2 days
