I have been working in Bourne since I qualified as a Staff Nurse in 1995 and have been a District Nurse at the Galletly Practice since 1999 after gaining my degree in Community Health and District Nursing. My nursing career has always been rather “full-on” following a complete change in direction as my first career was in banking! Three years ago I was awarded the Queen’s Nurse title of which I am immensely proud especially as my written work for application (nearly 10,000 words of reflective analysis of my practice) had to be supported by commendations from several of my patients and my peers. Thirteen Nurses were awarded the title throughout the UK and the number has now increased to nearly one hundred nursing professionals.

I am currently on secondment to the Department of Health (DH) as Clinical Lead for Nursing on

the Transforming Community Services Programme. I am in London for two days a week and work in clinical practice in Bourne for the remaining three days. My office on the South Bank is fantastic – huge windows looking directly down on the Thames with St. Pauls Cathedral directly opposite – it’s a wonder I ever get any work done with such a view!

I am very proud of the care that is delivered to our patients in Bourne – my passion is palliative and end of life nursing and through my work at the DH I have been very involved in the writing and production of a clinical guide of best practice for end of life care that is now National Policy.
